SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Sanctioned by ADGA and their rules shall govern. The base date will be the date of each show.
2. This show is sanctioned for Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Toggenburg, Recorded Grade. This is the order of the show as well. Although show committee has the right to change show order if need be to keep the show running in a smooth and orderly fashion.
3. Original registration papers and/or stamped duplicate must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show. Original registration papers are required on all animals six (6) months of age or older. ADGA stamped duplicate accepted on the animals less than six (6) months of age.
4. **THERE ARE NO HORNS ALLOWED.**
5. JR's & SR's are separately sanctioned for doe shows.

HEALTH RULES

1. All animals will be unloaded at a designated location and health checks will take place by the Health Committee. Ohio State Health Regulations shall govern. Anyone requiring veterinary services is responsible for any charges incurred.
2. Animal coming in from outside Ohio must have a 30-day health papers for interstate travel. Papers and the animals will be checked in accordance with the Ohio health rules. Health papers should state the animals have no signs of Scrapies or Foot & Mouth disease.

ENTRIES AND FEES

1. Entries **postmarked by May 17, 2009 are \$3.50 per head per show.** All entries postmarked after May 17, 2009 to the date of the show will be charged a late entry fee of \$5.00 per head, per show. If animals are pre-entered only for one show and then the exhibitor chooses to add on additional shows, they will not be charged a late entry for the following shows.
2. A check or money order must accompany the entry form with the full amount of the entry fees and extra pen fees in U.S. Funds. SWODGA will not be responsible for cash that is sent in the mail. **NO REFUNDS.**
3. Exhibitors must have health release papers from the checker before checking in at the secretary's table.

CLUB RULES

1. Gates will open Friday, May 22, 2009 at 5:00 pm. Arrivals must be between 5:00 and 11:00 pm. and no arrivals before 6:00 am. Day of show. Early arrivals must be cleared prior to the show with the show chairperson.
2. Animals must be in place by 8:00 am. On the day of the show. Except Bucks, they are to be in place by 3:00 pm. On Saturday.
3. Judging will begin at 9:00 am Eastern daylight savings time on both days. Buck show will start approx. at 5:00 pm Sat. 5-24-08.
4. Pens will be assigned at the show site. They will be assigned on the basis of age and sex. If an animal needs an individual pen, this must be stated on the entry form and an extra pen fee of \$5.00 will be charged for each pen.
5. Pens cannot be guaranteed **unless the exhibitor is pre-entered**. Late additional entries cannot be guaranteed space adjacent to original entries.
6. Bucks will be housed in the same barns as does, **bucks 5 months and older must be tied**.
7. **NO DOGS** will be allowed in the barns or in the show arenas at anytime.
8. **Milk is to be dumped in the designated areas only**.
9. South Western Ohio Dairy Goat Association and/or Highland Co. Agricultural Society will not be held responsible for the loss, damage or accident to any person, animal or personal property at the fairgrounds.
10. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances will be permitted on the Fairgrounds. **NO SMOKING PERMITTED IN THE BARNs.**
11. Any person or family not exhibiting proper behavior as judged by the show committee will be required to leave the Highland Co. Fairgrounds immediately and will not be permitted to return for the remainder of the two days of shows. Parents/guardians or an adult willing to take responsibility for child/children under 18 are required to control their child/children at all times or proper authorities will be called and ALL will be asked to leave immediately. All buildings not being used for the SWODGA SPRING CLASSIC DAIRY GOAT SHOW are off limits to everyone.
12. Camping will be available for \$20.00 per night (this includes electric and water). **NO ELECTRIC HOOK-UPS TO CAMPERS IN BARNs. EVERYONE PAYS FOR CAMPING WITH OR WITHOUT ELECTRIC HOOK-UPS.**
13. Food will be available on grounds for purchase.
14. The secretary's table will be open for check-in on Friday 8-10 pm. Saturday 6-8 am. and 8-10 pm. Sunday between 6-8 am. (Bucks arriving late on Saturday need to be checked in by the Health Committee and then check in with the Show Secretary's table before 3 pm and before unloading).
15. No hay or straw will be furnished. There will be hay and straw available for sale on a first come basis.

SATURDAY YOUTH SHOW CLUB RULES

1. All animals in the Youth Show must be in the child's or children's name, family name or herd name. If in the herd name or family name a **letter from ADGA is required**. If the child has an animal leased through an Official 4-H agent, FFA advisor or ADGA lease, the lease must be dated by May 1st and a copy of the lease must be enclosed. **The child's name must appear on the entry form to be eligible to show in the Youth Shows**. Breeds that will be sanctioned will be: SR & JR Does – Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, AOP & Recorded Grades. This will be the show order as well. Due to not enough goats entered in the past we are forced to AOP some breeds. **Champion Challenge will not be offered in the Youth show**.

YOUTH PREMIUMS OFFERED-Sponsored by SWODGA & many other donators that are listed on the SWODGA web site. Premiums for BSDIS & BJSIS, SR GCH, SR RCH's, JR GCH's, JR RCH's & placings 1st thru 3rd premiums will be offered. Also \$ for the exhibitor that drove the furthest & \$ for the exhibitor with the most goats entered and shown. (in exhibitors name).

SPECIAL INFORMATION AND ACTIVITIES

Senior, Intermediate, Junior and Pee Wee showmanship and Showman of Showman after lunch. Showmanship is for those youth that are either showing in the Youth Show or Pre-entered n SWODGA Spring Classic Open Shows (age groups to be announced at the show after sign up). Classes will be placed up to third place each will receive the following: 1st Place Rosette, Trophy & \$15.00, 2nd Place Rosette & \$10.00 and 3rd Place Rosette & 5.00. All first place winners except Pee Wee will compete in the Showman of Showman classes. The winner will receive a Showman of Showman Trophy sponsored by SWODGA. No entry fee required.
